Report to Commission RE: Awards Special Committee

The Rules Committee met on January 8, 2007 and recommended the following charge to the Awards Special Committee:

- The committee will consist of four (4) county commissioners who will serve a two year term beginning in January. The nominating committee will initially recommend two commissioners for two year terms and two commissioners for one year terms. After the initial appointments, the nominating committee will recommend two commissioners each January. The recommendations of the nominating committee will be subject to approval by the full commission. In addition to the county commissioners, the committee will include an elected county official and a business leader. The elected official and business leader will be chosen by the commissioner members of the committee and will serve one year terms.
- The committee will be responsible for selecting a Citizen of the Year. In addition, the committee will be responsible for selecting a citizen each month to receive a certificate to be known as the Putnam County Commission Character Award for the months of January through November. The Citizen of the Year shall be chosen from the current year recipients of the Putnam County Commission Character Awards. The criteria for selecting the monthly award will be *Character Counts – a project of the Josephson Institute of Ethics*. The committee will select award winners from written nominations solicited from community through newspapers, internet, radio and other means as determined by the committee.
- The committee will also be responsible for selecting a County Employee of the Year and a County Employee of the Month. The County Employee of the Year will be selected from the current year recipients of the County Employee of the Month. The criteria for selecting the monthly awards will be the same as the criteria for the citizen award. Nominations for the employee awards may be submitted by elected officials or the employee's supervisor.
- All awards will be to a living person. No posthumous awards.

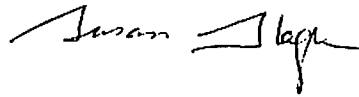

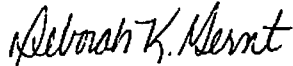
