WHEREAS, the City of Cookeville, Tennessee; the City of Algood, Tennessee; the Town of Monterey, Tennessee; and Putnam County, Tennessee, have entered into an agreement to operate and establish the Putnam County Rail Trail Authority to be formally named the **Tennessee Central Heritage Rail Trail Authority**, and pursuant to said agreement, said governmental entities are responsible for the maintenance, utilities and insurance regarding the operation of said authority; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Cookeville; the City Council of the City of Algood; the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Monterey; and the Putnam County Commission deem it advisable to establish a Public Building Authority pursuant to said agreement for the purposes of operating, maintaining and managing the Rail Trail Authority, in addition to those powers enumerated in *Tennessee Code Annotated*, § 12-10-109, and *Tennessee Code Annotated*, § 12-9-101, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, an application in compliance with *Tennessee Code Annotated*, § 12-10-104, has been submitted to the governing bodies of the City of Cookeville; the City of Algood; the Town of Monterey; and Putnam County seeking permission to apply for the incorporation of said Public Building Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PUTNAM COUNTY COMMISSION that it is wise, expedient, necessary and/or advisable that the Public Building Authority be formed to be known as the **Tennessee Central Heritage Rail Trail Authority**; and the applicants for same are hereby authorized to proceed to form such authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE PUTNAM COUNTY COMMISSION, that the City of Cookeville, Tennessee; the City of Algood, Tennessee; the Town of Monterey, Tennessee; and Putnam County, Tennessee, will continue to operate the Authority pursuant to the Agreement among said governmental entities dated November 9, 2005, until modified by said governmental entities, as part of the formation of this newly established corporate body known as the Tennessee Central Heritage Rail Trail Authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE PUTNAM COUNTY COMMISSION that the provisions contained in the By-Laws and/or Corporate Agreement of Tennessee Central Heritage Rail Trail Authority as attached hereto are hereby adopted.

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION
OF
TENNESSEE CENTRAL HERITAGE RAIL TRAIL AUTHORITY

Pursuant to the provisions of the Public Building Authorities Act of 1971, as amended, codified as Title 12, Chapter 10, *Tennessee Code Annotated*, and pursuant to *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Title 12-9-101, et seq., which authorizes public agencies to enter into interlocal cooperative agreements, the undersigned governmental entities do hereby intend to create a public building authority pursuant to said Acts and do hereby certify as follows:

1. Each of us is the duly qualified representative of the respective governmental entity and our respective names and addresses are as follows:

2. The name of the authority shall be **Tennessee Central Heritage Rail Trail Authority**.
3. Permission to organize the Authority has been granted by resolution duly adopted by the City Council of Cookeville, Tennessee, on _____; the City Council of Algood, Tennessee, on _____; the Board of Aldermen of Monterey, Tennessee, on _____; and the Putnam County Commission on _____.
4. The address of the Authority's initial registered office is 45 East Broad Street, Cookeville, Tennessee 38501.

5. The name of the Authority's initial registered agent is Jim Shipley, City Manager, 45 East Broad Street, Cookeville, Tennessee 38501.
6. The location of the principal office of the Authority is 45 East Broad Street, Cookeville, Tennessee 38501.
7. The purposes of which the Authority is being organized are, among others, the operation of the Rail Trail Authority to be known as the **Tennessee Central Heritage Rail Trail Authority**; the operation and ownership of the Rail Trail Authority which shall include all necessary constructing, acquiring, improving, repairing, renovating, extending, equipping, furnishing, operating, maintaining and managing such equipment, trailheads, trails, locomotives, rail cars, right-of-ways, rails, and managing any one or more "projects" as defined in the Act, within or without the County of Putnam, including the power to demolish existing structures, as provided in the Act; the borrowing of funds to carry out any of its purposes and powers with respect to any such project or projects and the lending of funds for any such purpose; the lending of funds to municipal corporations in Tennessee, including Tennessee cities, counties and utility districts, for the purpose of financing any undertaking that is eligible to be financed by bonds, notes, interim certificates or other obligations issued pursuant to law by any such municipal corporation, the State of Tennessee, or any agency, authority, branch, bureau, commission, corporation, department, or instrumentality thereof and execution of loan agreements and leases with such municipal corporations in connection with such lending of funds; and the exercise of any and all powers conferred by the laws and statutes of the State of Tennessee, including the Act.
8. The Authority shall have ten (10) members, all of whom shall have such qualifications, terms and duties as provided in the Act, as heretofore or hereafter amended.
9. The duration of the Authority is perpetual.
10. The Authority shall be a public nonprofit corporation and public instrumentality of the governmental entities, the City of Cookeville, Tennessee; the City of Algood, Tennessee; the Town of Monterey, Tennessee; and Putnam County, Tennessee, as provided in the Act, but shall have no power to obligate any of said governmental entities in any way, as provided in the Act.

The Authority, as a public nonprofit corporation and public instrumentality of the governmental entities, shall not assume

ownership of or responsibility for municipal structures; sidewalks, parks, roadways, buildings, displays, parking facilities, right of ways, etc. that may become integrated into the Trail Authority projects. Such municipal structures will remain under the ownership and governance of the municipality in which it is located. The Trail Authority will be responsible for ensuring that each municipality, in which a structure may become an integral component of a Trail Authority project, is aware of the standards, theme, aesthetics, public safety, funding restraints and other aspects of the project that may have impact upon the maintenance, operations, lease and/or disposal of said structures by the municipality.

11. The Authority shall have all powers necessary to carry out the purposes set forth above as are authorized under the laws of the State of Tennessee, including without limitation the Act, as heretofore and hereafter amended, and including all powers incidental thereto or necessary for the performance thereof, excepting only such lawful limitations on, and additions to, such powers and authorities as expressly provided herein. To that end, it is hereby declared that should any provision or provisions of this Certificate of Incorporation, which limit(s) or add(s) to such powers and authorities be declared invalid, unlawful, or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity, unlawfulness, or unenforceability of such provision or provisions shall not affect the remaining provisions of such Certificate of Incorporation, and that this Certificate of Incorporation should have full force and effect according to its provisions excepting those provision(s) so declared invalid, unlawful, or unenforceable.
12. Any action required or permitted by the Act to be taken at a Board of Directors meeting may be taken without a meeting. If all directors consent to taking such action without a meeting, the affirmative vote of the number of directors that would be necessary to authorize or take such action at a meeting is the act of the Board of Directors. Such action must be evidenced by one or more written consents describing the action taken, at least one of which is signed by each director, indicating the director's vote or abstention on the action, which consents shall be included in the minutes or filed with the corporate records of the Authority reflecting the action taken. Action taken by consent is effective when the last director signs the consent, unless the consent specifies a different effective date. Copies of such consent actions shall be provided forthwith to each director.

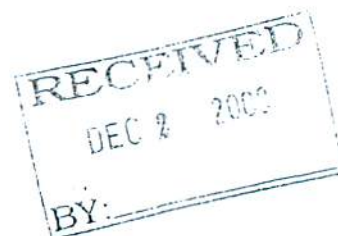

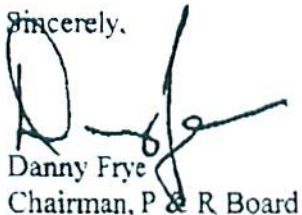
